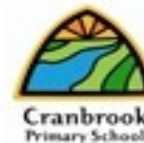

Consultation for an Additional Resource Provision for Children with ASD at Cranbrook Primary School

Following the success of the **Specialist Behaviour Support Provision (CUBE)** at **Cranbrook Primary** which opened in **September 2016**, the school is in negotiation with the **Local Authority** to open a **12 place Special Provision for children with (Autism Spectrum Disorder)**. This would initially open as a pilot in **September 2019** and would be fully funded by the local authority through the **High Needs Funding**.

As a school with many years of providing for the needs of children with **ASD**, we are very excited to have the additional resources provision sited at our school. This proposal comes following consultation with parents with in Redbridge over the past 2 years. You are invited to express your views through a survey available on our website via a link.
